Lunch Boxes

As the weather warms up, please add an ice pack to your child's lunch box if you feel the contents need to be chilled. Unfortunately, we do not have the fridge space to store the lunch boxes.

Please do not add sweets or chocolate to the lunch box as we promote healthy eating and remember we are a nut free school.

Clothing and Footwear

You would be surprised by the number of clothes that are all the same and it can be hard to make sure they are reunited with their rightful owners. As children will be discarding layers on sunny days, please name all their clothes to avoid confusion.

Please be reminded that children need to wear shoes for school – NO OPEN TOED SANDALS PLEASE. Canvas shoes with velcro fastenings are great and enable your child to fully explore the environment and minimise the risk of tripping over. Shoulders should also be covered to avoid sunburn.

Please could you apply sunscreen before your child attends – we are unable to apply sunscreen during the session. There are a number 'all day' suncreams available.
